

- When decreasing level restrictions (move from yellow to green, etc.) a buffer period of 7-days after the resolution of any cases stated by PHSD will be used to examine the situation and ensure safety prior to lessening restrictions.
- For the purposes of the re-opening threshold, it is assumed that the On-reserve population is estimated at approximately 923 residents, (as per ISC Registry).
